May 27, 2018



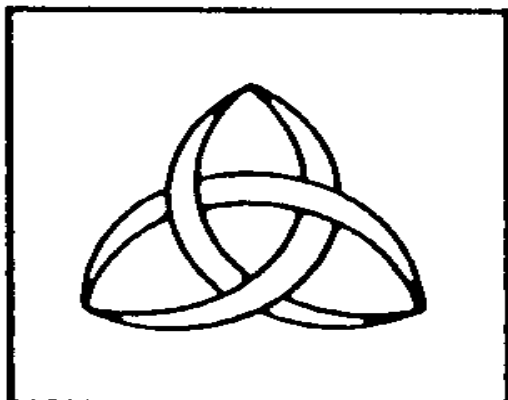
Jesus must have built anticipation among his disciples when said, “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me” (Matthew 28:18). With all the power in the world that he had at his command, when he could have done anything and ordered everything, Jesus then said “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (28:19-20). This, then, is what is most powerful: pass on the faith, teach others the way, and invite them to follow. This is what can transform the world.

Matthew’s Gospel ends with a reassurance from Jesus to his disciples: I am with you always, until the end of the age” (28:20). Throughout history from creation to the birth of Jesus, God accompanied humanity. But during Jesus’ ministry, God accompanied those who responded to the call in a more immediate way. Now, with the coming of the Holy Spirit, God accompanies us in the most intimate way.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity – three, but One – reveals the importance of relationship. The intimate relationship between Father, Son, and the Spirit is an essential part of God’s identity. From the beginning of time, God has been in relationship. God has never been alone.

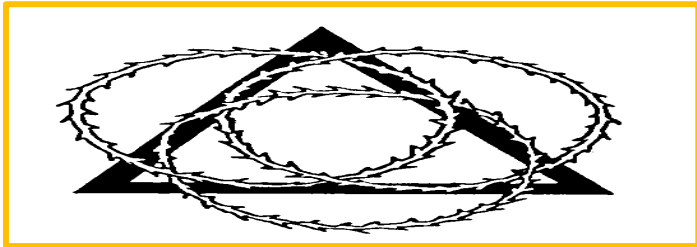

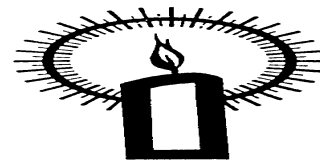
